#### WHO CAN DISPLAY ART...

The library is seeking small quilts or wall hangings for display in our upcoming Red, White + Words to be displayed at the library in December. This exhibit is to accompany the Melrose Victorian era signature quilt's homecoming to the Beebe Estate this winter. Open to all quilters 18 years and older. Preference will be given first to Melrose residents and then to artists with a Melrose connection.

#### WHAT SHOULD I DO ...

We require 1-3 examples of your piece(s) sent electronically for approval with your application. Applications are due by October 17th. If your quilt is selected for display, you will be contacted by a staff member with the details for delivery.

#### ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS...

All quilts must be ready to hang (split sleeve or other hanging apparatus attached). The exhibit will run from mid-November through mid-January and remain in place for the duration of the display. Due to space limitations, quilts or wall hangings are not to exceed 30" in any direction.
